People Who Help

What You Need:

Paper, washable markers, and fun stickers

What You Do:

Draw the outline of a gingerbread person on a piece of paper. (It's okay if it isn't perfect!)

Say, "Look at this paper. What do you see? (Pause.) That's right. It's the outline of a person!

"Today in our Bible story, we heard how Ananias helped Paul. We have lots of people in our lives who help us. Can you name some of the people who help you? I'll write your answers on the page. As I write, you can color the person or add fun stickers."

Encourage your child to name people who help them. If they get stumped, give them hints! (Think: firefighters, police officers, teachers, counselors, small group leaders, mommies, daddies, garbage collectors, etc.)

Say, "Wow! Look at all the people who help us. Jesus sent Ananias to help Paul, and Jesus gives us people to help us. Yay, Jesus! We can follow Jesus here, there, and everywhere because Jesus wants to be my friend forever. Who wants to be your friend forever? Jesus wants to be my friend forever."

Prayer

"Dear God, thank You so much for giving us people to help us. You help us, too, because you want to be our friend forever. We love You! Amen."
