Position Summary:

Upstate Church is looking to add a full-time Audio Coordinator to its Production Team. The Audio Coordinator will work closely with the Production Director and Production Team in the operation of weekly services, management of equipment including the procurement, operation, and installation of new equipment, as well as other duties related to the provision of excellence in production spaces.

Essential Duties and Accountabilities:

- Able to program and operate Yamaha QL / CL and DM series consoles
- Able to mix on large-format deployments for rooms designed for 800+ occupants
- Experience in the integration and operation of Waves Processing in Live environments
- Experience in advanced deployment and management of Large-Scale Dante Networks
- Willingness to mix to the standard and style already established for a campus constant experience
- Experience in common installation practices to include cable pulls, cable terminations, equipment rack building, etc.
- Any additional experience with Q-Sys, Shure Wireless Workbench, Bitfocus Companion, BlackMagic Software, would be preferred.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
