

- Senior Saints averaged 125 in attendance

Missions

- Sent 405 people on over 20 different trips
- 141 first-time trip-goers
- Assisted local non-profit organizations
- Several projects assisted senior-adult members
- Gathered food and distributed to local pantry

Evangelism

- 12,679 connections that led to 5,644 gospel conversations
- All campuses and gatherings recorded gospel conversations
- 37 individual groups recorded gospel conversations
- Sent five character coaches into local schools

Groups

- Launched 42 new groups across all campuses with the DEEPER initiative
- 27 percent increase in individuals who attended groups

Worship

- Launched semi-annual Modern Worship Night
- Created resources and identified coaches to help vocalists and instrumentalists take their skills to the next level
- Choir and Orchestra joined seven other SC Baptist churches for a combined night of worship that broadcast across multiple platforms

Upstate Sports

- 511 students participated in league basketball
- 266 students participated in league soccer
- 100 campers with 31 responding to the gospel at basketball camp
- 25% of students indicate no church affiliation
